Prior to calling the meeting to order, the Traffic Safety Committee will do an on-site tour to inspect the locations listed on the agenda. Members of the public are welcome to join the tour.

1. Intersection of Carpenter Street and Third Avenue — Request for a new stop sign for southbound traffic on Carpenter Street and Third Avenue.
2. Intersection of Ocean Ave. and Junipero Street — Review a request to add lighting at the intersection of Ocean Ave. and Junipero Street.
3. North side of Sixth Street between Torres Street and Santa Fe Street — Request for a No Parking post on the north side of Sixth Avenue.
4. North and South sides of Mountain View between Crespi Ave and Vizcaino Avenue — Request for No Parking signs on both sides of Mountain View between Crespi Avenue and Vizcaino Avenue.
5. Southwest corner of Dolores Street and Ninth Avenue — Request for a Loading Zone on the southwest corner of Dolores Street and Ninth Avenue, south of the ADA parking space.
6. Rio Road crosswalk east of Atherton Drive. - Request to assess the pedestrian safety, signage, and visibility of the crosswalk on Rio Road east of Atherton Drive.

7. Northeast Corner of 10th and Monte Verde — Request for no parking posts
