HOW TO OFFER PUBLIC COMMENT

The public may give public comment at this meeting in person or use the Zoom teleconference module, provided that there is access to Zoom during the meeting. Comments must be received at least 2 hours before the meeting in order to be provided to the Committee. Comments received after that time and up to the beginning of the meeting will be made part of the record.

CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

PUBLIC COMMENT

Under the Brown Act, public comment for matters not the agenda must relate to the subject matter jurisdiction of this legislative body (Traffic Safety Committee). Public comment for items on the agenda must relate to that agenda item. Members of the public will be given 3 minutes to make their comment unless otherwise adjusted by the chair. If a member of the public attending the meeting remotely violates the Brown Act by failing to comply with these requirements of the Brown Act, then that speaker will be muted.

OLD BUSINESS

These are items previously discussed requiring follow-up

- 3) Second discussion of the AB 413 parking impacts.
- 4) Review a previous request to paint a crosswalk path at the end of the Jane Powers walkway at San Antonio between Second and Fourth Avenues.

- 8) Review a request for a new stop sign for southbound traffic on Carpenter Street and Third Avenue.
- 9) Review a request for No Parking posts on the Northeast corner of Tenth Avenue and Monte Verde Street.
- 10) Review a request for No Parking signs on both sides of Mountain View between Crespi Avenue and Viscaino Avenue.
- 11) Review a request for a Loading Zone on the southwest corner of Dolores Street and Ninth Avenue, south of the ADA parking space.
- 12) Review a request to paint a Green Zone at Lincoln Street and Sixth Avenue.
