Jeff Burghardt, President and Creative Director of Burghardt+Dore, gave a presentation on marketing efforts and responded to questions from the Council and the public.

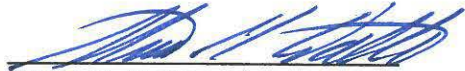
