OLD BUSINESS

- A.** Second review of resident request for speed reduction along Torres Street, between

Ocean and Sixth Avenues, to discourage the use of Torres as a short-cut.

- B. Second review of the effectiveness of the stop-controlled intersection at Junipero Street and Seventh Avenue, including the initial pedestrian crosswalk across Seventh Avenue in the west leg of the intersection.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

- A. Northeast Junipero Street and Fourth Avenue, and Northeast San Carlos Street and Ninth Avenue; consider a request from Monterey Salinas Transit (MST) to remove a total of four (4) parking stalls in front of two (2) MST bus stops.
- B. Carpenter Street, 2 northwest of First Avenue; consider a request to install a fence along the west side of Carpenter Street for pedestrian safety.
- C. Northwest San Carlos Street and Sixth Avenue; consider a request to change a red no parking zone to a yellow commercial loading zone.
- D. Santa Rita Street, between Ocean and Sixth Avenues; consider a request for resident permit-only parking.
- E. Guadalupe Street, between Seventh and Mountain View Avenues; consider a request to add additional "No Parking" posts.
- F. Review possible locations for a Carmel Rotary Club sign at the entrance into the City, such as on Carpenter Street or Rio Road.
